Currently, the United States has the highest incarceration rate in the world. Within 3 years after being released nearly two-thirds of individuals return back to prison, many of which are due to parole violations.^{1,2} An estimated 9 out of 10 parole violators are unemployed, and depending on their educational attainment, nearly 40 percent of prisoners are unemployed just prior to being incarcerated.³ Less than a decade ago, it cost some states 5 times more to incarcerate inmates, than to educate them.⁴

Today, college courses are offered to inmates at 35 percent of prisons in the United States. Education is one of the most important tools to curb repeat offenses, as well as, securing
